When this change takes effect, all civil and family proceedings will be in person unless the Court otherwise orders or directs.

Until February 1, 2023, the default manner of attendance for trial management conferences will continue to be by telephone or Teams Audio pursuant to Rule 23.1-1(1) of the *Supreme Court Civil Rules* and Rule 22.1-1(1) of the *Supreme Court Family Rules*.
