

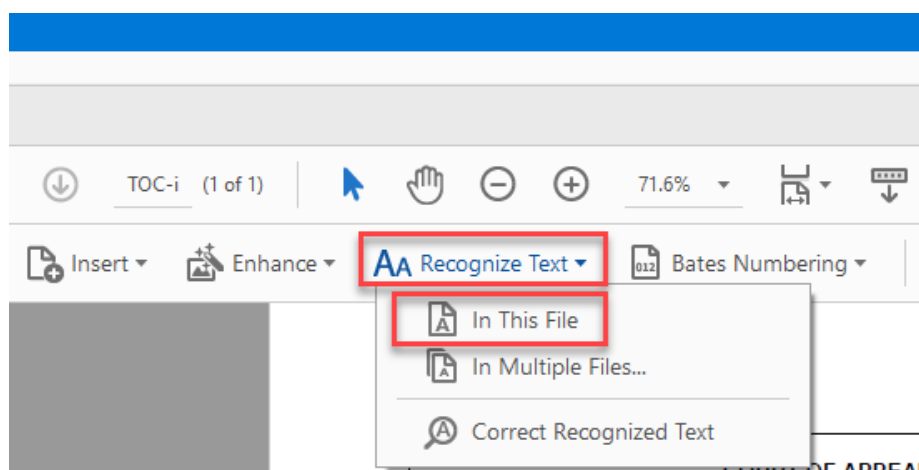
# OPTICAL CHARACTER RECOGNITION (OCR)

## RECOGNIZE TEXT IN SCANNED PDF DOCUMENTS

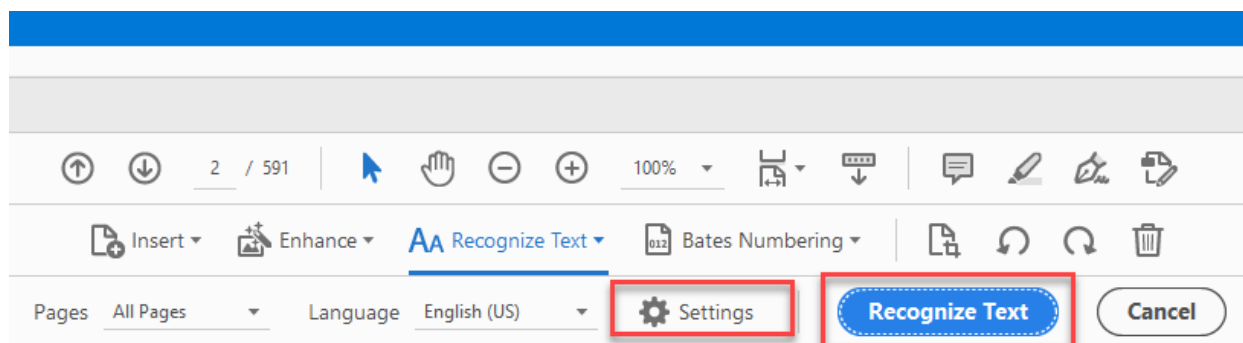
*NOTE: There are several methods of adding OCR information to a PDF document and this is just one of them. The instructions are intended only as a general description of the process. These instructions were prepared using Adobe Acrobat DC Pro. Your procedure may vary depending on which PDF creation software you are using.*

Optical Character Recognition (OCR) is a technology that enables you to convert different types of documents, such as scanned paper documents, PDF files or images captured by a digital camera into editable and searchable data.

1. Open your scanned document in Adobe Acrobat DC.
2. Go to **Tools > Scan & OCR**
3. On the Toolbar, Click **Recognize Text > In This File**



4. Apply your **Settings** choices then Click **Recognize Text**



5. **Save** your document.
