Practice Direction

Garnishing Orders

Summary:

This Practice Direction concerns applications for garnishing orders.

Direction:

1. A person applying under the *Court Order Enforcement Act* for a garnishing order before or after judgment must file a Requisition in Form 17.
2. The fee for filing the application for a garnishing order is payable at the time the application is presented to the registry.
3. If the application is rejected, the Requisition and original affidavit will not be returned to the applicant. An applicant wishing to file a new application must file a new Requisition and affidavit.
4. If a judge or associate judge requires additional material in support of the application for a garnishing order, a further filing fee will not be payable when the additional material is submitted to the registry along with a copy of the Requisition as returned to her/him by the registry.
