Practice Direction

Garnishing Orders

Summary:

This Practice Direction concerns applications for garnishing orders.

Direction:

- 1. A person applying under the *Court Order Enforcement Act* for a garnishing order before or after judgment must file a Requisition in Form 17.
- 2. The fee for filing the application for a garnishing order is payable at the time the application is presented to the registry.
- 3. If the application is rejected, the Requisition and original affidavit will not be returned to the applicant. An applicant wishing to file a new application must file a new Requisition and affidavit.
- 4. If a judge or associate judge requires additional material in support of the application for a garnishing order, a further filing fee will not be payable when the additional material is submitted to the registry along with a copy of the Requisition as returned to her/him by the registry.
