# **Criminal Practice Direction**

## **French or Bilingual Criminal Jury Trials**

### Summary:

On December 1, 2000, the Associate Chief Justice issued a Notice directing that all criminal jury trials in the French language be heard in New Westminster, unless the Court ordered otherwise. With an increase in the number of French-speaking prospective jurors in the Lower Mainland, it is now possible to hold French or bilingual criminal jury trials in Vancouver as well as in New Westminster.

### Direction:

- 1. This practice direction applies to cases where an order has been granted directing a French or bilingual trial, and the accused is to be tried by a judge and jury.
- 2. All French or bilingual criminal jury trials will be held in New Westminster or Vancouver, whichever is closest to the place of the indictment, unless the Court orders otherwise.
- 3. Applications for a French or bilingual criminal jury trial to be held other than in New Westminster or Vancouver shall be made to the Associate Chief Justice.
