DIRECTION TO THE REGISTRY

Grace Period to May 30, 2012 for Registry Acceptance of Repealed Forms 8, 35, 79, F37, F38, F51, F52, F53 and F85

By Order in Council 192, approved and ordered on March 29, 2012, the following Supreme Court Civil and Family Forms are repealed and new Forms are substituted effective April 25, 2012:

- Form 8 Default Judgment
- Form 35 Order Made After Application
- Form 79 Order For Indigent Status
- Form F37 Child Support Affidavit
- Form F38 Affidavit Desk Order Divorce
- Form 51 Order Made After Application
- Form F52 Final Order
- Form F54 Restraining Order
- Form F85 Order for Indigent Status

I am directing that until May 30, 2012, Registry staff should continue to accept the former Forms.

The reason I am directing that this 'grace period' be extended is that I have been informed that software changes required in relation to some of the above listed Forms may not be completed by April 25, 2012.
